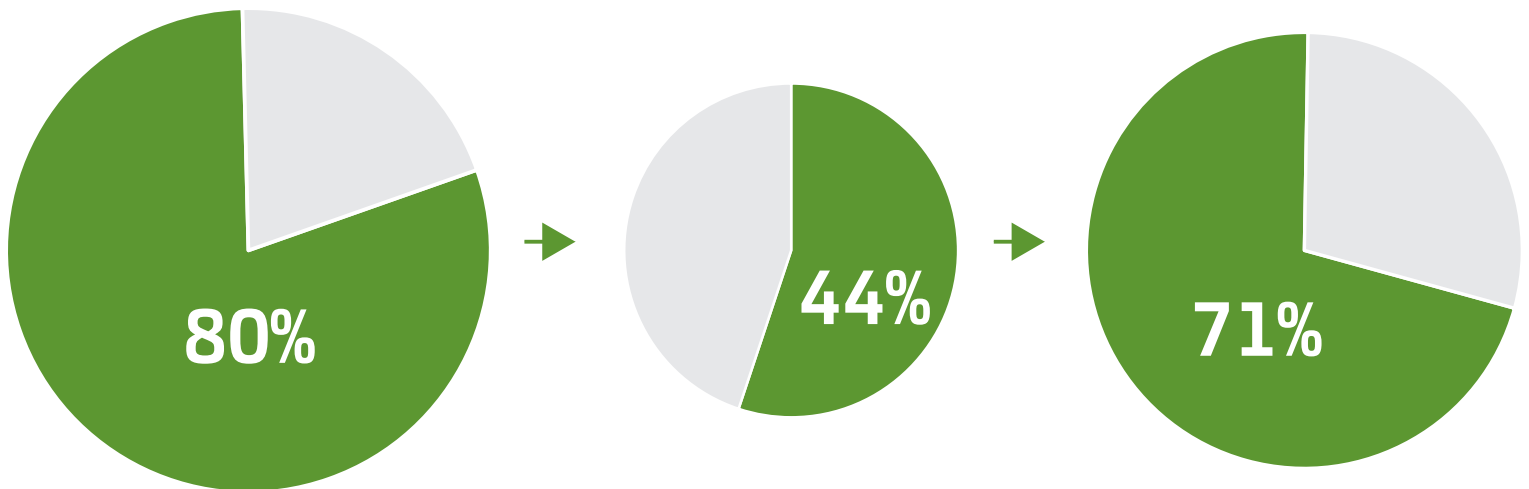
of people with IDD do not have a paid job in the community.

44%

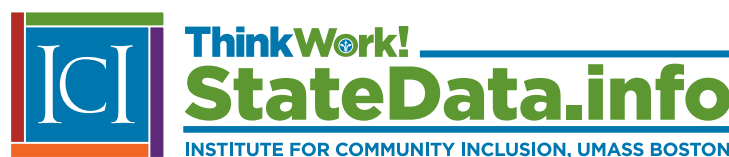
of those who don't have a paid job in the community want one.
