

# States Vary in the Percentage of People with Intellectual Disabilities Who Apply to Vocational Rehabilitation and Progress to Services

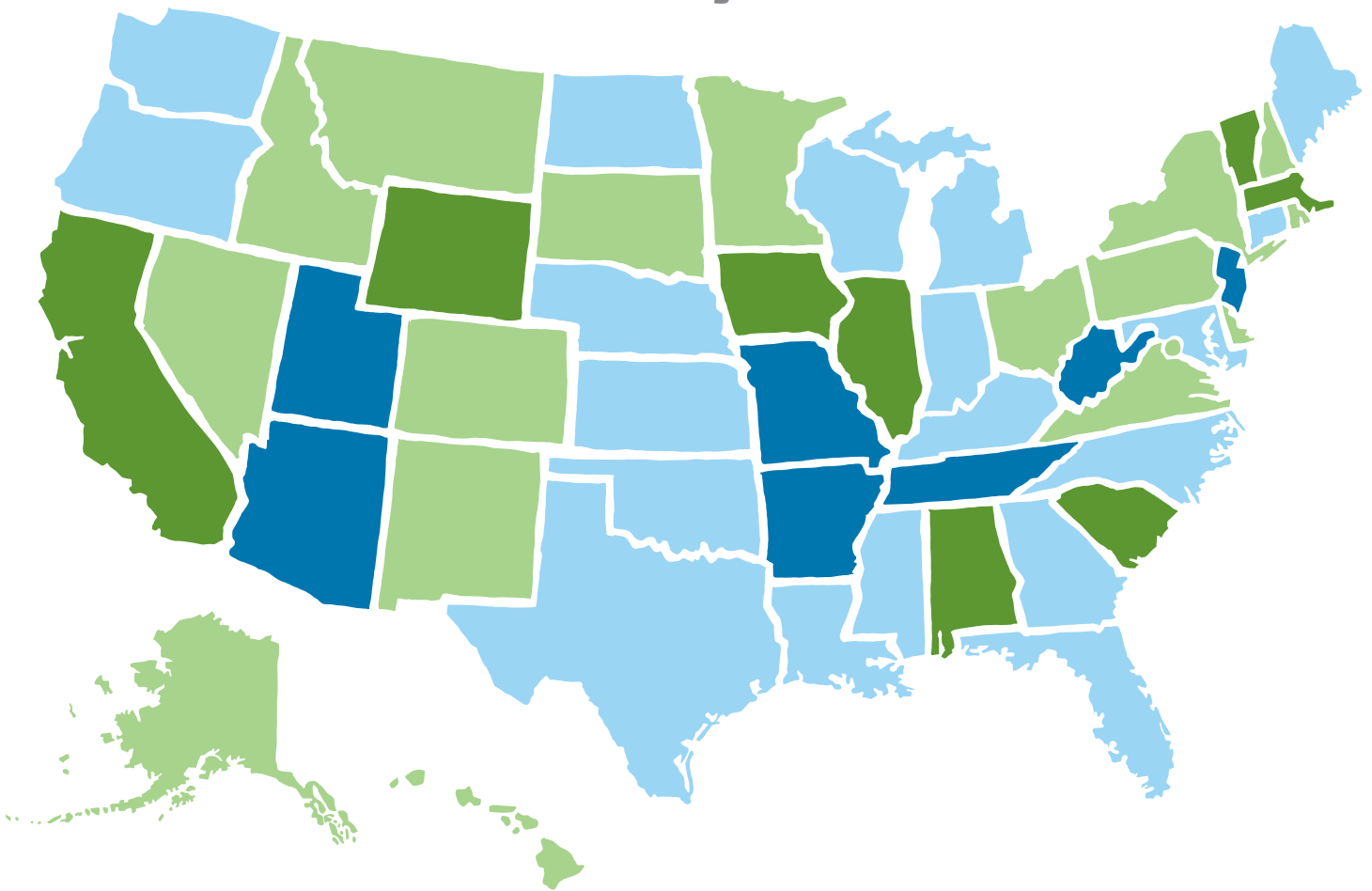
